

Rapid Fire Presentations

New for this year are the “Rapid Fire” oral presentations where presenters get 5 minutes to present approximately 3 slides summarising the research that they are working on. Attendees interested in subjects presented during the rapid-fire oral session can visit the accompanying poster and have a more in-depth discussion with the rapid-fire presenters. This format is expected to offer greater exposure to presenters, as well as give attendees a snapshot into the wide variety of research being conducted. The majority of the presenters will be early career researchers and/or presenters chosen as their research is a ‘hot topic’ or novel.

Guidelines for rapid fire presenters:

You will have 5 minutes maximum to present your work.

Please prepare some powerpoint slides. As a guide 3 slides would be appropriate but no more than 5 slides are to be presented.

Questions will not be taken during this session, delegates will have the opportunity to discuss your research further at your poster session.

All powerpoint slides will need to be uploaded prior to your session.
